**CLASS RULES**

Classes consist of 12 hours of classroom instruction, education and awareness. The 12 hours are split between two days.

Saturday 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM

Sunday 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM

There will be a short break for lunch both days.

1. You are expected to arrive at the class site on time. Unless otherwise stated, by your instructor, classes will begin promptly at the time stated in your letter. **If you are more than 15 minutes late, you will be considered absent.**

2. **You are required to attend the full session, both days. Failure to attend either session, timely, will result in your being dismissed from the entire cycle and will require you to reschedule and timely attend the entire weekend.**

3. **DO NOT** attempt to attend a class under the influence of alcohol or drugs. If this is suspected, your class instructor is required to see that you are escorted home by the local police or a family member. If the substance suspected is alcohol, you can clear yourself by submitting to a breathalyzer test. If you test positive or refuse to submit to the test, the instructor will proceed as outlined above. This act is grounds for supervision revocation and a referral to your county treatment program.

4. **DO NOT** attempt to drive to class if your license has been suspended. If this is suspected, your class instructor is required to contact the local police. Find other transportation to class.

This course is not intended to stop people from drinking; each individual is responsible for his/her own decisions in that regard. However, it will be clearly stated that the main concern of this course is the tragic combination of drinking and driving.
