

FAMILY BASED MENTAL HEALTH

County Caseworker 2

This Caseworker 2 position provides services to consumers and their families during non-traditional hours such as evenings and weekends when necessary and appropriate. This position serves in an on-call rotation for crisis intervention/support services with participating families. Collaborate with consumers, families and other involved agencies to locate and access all community resources and supportive services.

Special requirements are needed for Family Based Caseworker – Bachelors Degree in Psychology, sociology, social work, nursing, rehabilitation, pre-med, theology or anthropology, plus one year experience in a CASSP system program, or 12 college level semester hours in humanities or social services, plus one year of experience in a CASSP system program, plus be enrolled for certification by the Department of Public Welfare, Office on Mental Health (OMH) as a mental health family based worker, or Licensed registered nurse, plus one year of experience in a CASSP system program, plus be enrolled for certification by the Department of Public Welfare, OMH as a mental health family based worker.
