

WORK PLAN FOR THE 2020-2021 YEAR

1. The group will focus on various aspects of child find including child keep for all programs. While child find/child keep have been discussed over the past fiscal year, the group would like to review how child find occurs, how current demographics and changes in ethnic groups influence the outcome of child find and child keep. How the COVID pandemic has impacted referrals and services being provided to families. This activity will also correlate to the LICC Child Find Plan.
2. Coaching – programs will continue to work in implementing coaching. Programs will also continue their work in increasing positive interactions between young children and the adults supporting them. Programs enrolled in the coaching initiative will enhance parent trainings to reflect coaching strategies in family activities.
3. LICC partners will continue to support initiatives regarding infants impacted by families with substance use through participation in Plans of Safe Care.
4. LICC partners will continue to support families throughout the Pandemic regarding information and updates given by OCDEL for service delivery as well as, information regarding children enrolled in child care settings during a Pandemic. Families will also be informed of testing sites as well as vaccination sites for their usage if needed.
5. LICC partners will also continue to support the statewide priority of Inclusion. Partners will continue to support families and children who participate in early childhood settings as well as other community settings. The initiative to create a Rapid Response Team will continue to be a priority of LICC members.
6. LICC partner will continue with the statewide priority of child progress. Working together with ECE members to build on social relationship skills needed to succeed in home, community in early childhood and school settings.
