

WORK PLAN FOR THE 2018-2019 YEAR

1. The group will focus on various aspects of child find including child keep for all programs. While child find/child keep have been discussed over the past fiscal year, the group would like to review how child find occurs, how current demographics and changes in ethnic groups influence the outcome of child find and child keep. This activity will also correlate to the LICC Child Find Plan.
2. Calendars will be distributed to other agencies/program and physicians making referrals as a thank you and a reminder to make referrals..
3. Determine if the local programs are meeting families' needs as indicated through the annual family survey. The group will brainstorm what information should be included on an initial survey sent to families enter programming. As Head Start completes a community assessment which could be beneficial the LICC group in determining family needs.
4. Develop a statement on collaboration with early childhood partners regarding the implementation of the Reduction of Expulsion and Suspension in Early Childhood Programs in Pennsylvania announcement issued by the OCDEL. Continue to work with child care programs on implementing the announcement.
5. Coaching – programs will continue to work in implementing coaching.
6. Additional activities may be identified by the group through the year.
