

THE YOP PROCESS

Go to Magistrate as soon as possible. Tell the Magistrate you are taking YOP, and pleading not guilty. Then a hearing will be scheduled within appx. 30 days. (You will need to attend the hearing!)



ASAP!!!
Submit a completed YOP application and payment (\$175) to CMSU!



CMSU contacts you and schedules the YOP.



Complete the program within 30 days without having an additional alcohol violation.

Then you will need to take verification of YOP completion to Police Station immediately following completion of the YOP program! (prior to the hearing date)



Attend your hearing at the District Magistrate. Prior to the actual hearing you will be able to plea to a Disorderly Conduct. The fines/fees for the Disorderly Conduct will need to be paid at that time (no payment plan).



The Underage citation is changed to a Disorderly Conduct, drivers license is not suspended, and after 5 years with no further violations, you can petition the courts to have the citation expunged.

The YOP process is very time sensitive!

You will have a **TOTAL of 30 days to complete ALL Requirements!**

NOTE:

YOP Applications can be obtained at BU Office of Student Standards, Student Standards Website, area police departments, & CMSU.

Fees for the YOP Class and enrollment forms are to be mailed to CMSU.

YOP class fees must be paid prior to taking the YOP Class. No exceptions.
